

St. Joan of Arc Catholic School Requirements for Participation in Extra-Curricular Sports

The following rules are to be observed by all students involved in any extracurricular sports at St. Joan of Arc Catholic School:

1. All permission slips and paper work need to be signed and handed in before try outs.
2. Good sportsmanship shall be practiced at all times: foul language, unsportsmanlike motions, gestures, or conduct or disrespect will not be tolerated and could lead to suspension from a game and or to being removed from the team.
3. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to arrange rides to and from all practices and games for their child.
4. Scholastic requirements are:
 - a.) Students must maintain at least a “C” in all classes.
 - b.) Any student whose grade drops to a “D” will be suspended from games and practices until the grade is brought up to a “C”.
 - c.) Grades will be reviewed on an on-going basis.
 - d.) Any student who has an “F” will be removed the team.
5. Conduct and effort requirements are:
 - a.) Students must maintain at least a “2” in all classes throughout the season.
 - b.) Any “3” will result in suspension for a period of 2 weeks. Any “4” will result in being removed from the team.
 - c.) Receipt of 3 detention slips or 1 conduct will result in suspension from the sport for one week, to include all games and practices.
 - d.) Receipt of a second conduct slip will result the student being removed from the team for the remainder of the season.
 - e.) Suspension from school means being removed from the team entirely.

Students are not allowed to leave the school property while waiting for any extracurricular sports or activity to begin. Failure to obey this rule may result in suspension from the school as well as the team. The school’s discipline committee will enforce all rules and regulations. The decisions of the committee will be final.

Parents must sign their child out when leaving practices and games.
