



Ways to make a Planned Gift to the Diocese of Palm Beach

Stock/Securities - By giving a gift of appreciated securities, you can avoid paying capital gains on the stock or security, receive a charitable gift deduction on your tax return and the diocese, parish or diocesan ministry receives the full value of your security.

Matching Gifts - Many companies provide matching gifts for their employees as a benefit of their employment. Matching gifts are an excellent way to double and sometimes triple the impact of your personal donation. .

Endowments - An endowment is a permanent fund that holds its principal in perpetuity and is invested for the benefit of a particular purpose. By contributing money to an endowment, you create a source of income for the beneficiary and carry on your legacy of giving for generations to come.

Taxable IRA - Donors above 70.5 years of age may give a gift from their IRA (limited to \$105,000 per year per individual, which will be indexed for inflation starting in 2024). This counts towards your required minimum distribution (RMD) and is a way to avoid taxable income.

Wills - To leave a gift in your will, simply share this sentence with your attorney or financial planner: "I bequeath S_ _% of my estate to The Most Reverend Gerald M.

Barbarito, D.D., J.C.L, as Bishop of the Diocese of Palm Beach, his successors in Office, a corporation sole. I wish to designate the funds to (Your Parish, Ministry, or the Diocesan Services Appeal)."

Charitable Gift Annuity - A charitable gift annuity is when you give a sum of money, in this case to the Diocese of Palm Beach (minimum of \$25,000 for the Diocese of Palm Beach and donor must be 65 years or older), and they pay you a guaranteed quarterly annuity payments for the rest of your life.

Life Insurance - Name the Diocese of Palm Beach as the beneficiary of your life insurance policy. Simply contact your policy holder and ask for a Change of Beneficiary form.



DOMINGO DE RAMOS

En este Domingo de Ramos, cuando Nuestro Señor comienza la semana decisiva para nuestra salvación, dejémonos de consideraciones superficiales, vayamos a lo central, a lo que verdaderamente es importante. Lo que hemos de pretender es ir al cielo. Si no, nada vale la pena. Para ir al cielo, es indispensable la fidelidad a la doctrina de Cristo. Para ser fiel, es indispensable porfiar con constancia en nuestra contienda contra los obstáculos que se oponen a nuestra eterna felicidad.

El cristiano puede vivir con la seguridad de que, si desea luchar, Dios le cogerá de su mano derecha, como se lee en la Misa de esta fiesta. Jesús, que entra en Jerusalén cabalgando un pobre borrico, Rey de paz, es el que dijo: el reino de los cielos se alcanza a viva fuerza, y los que la hacen son los que lo arrebatan (Mt XI, 12.). Esa fuerza no se manifiesta en violencia contra los demás: es fortaleza para combatir las propias debilidades y miserias, valentía para no enmascarar las infidelidades personales, audacia para confesar la fe también cuando el ambiente es contrario.

La Semana Santa nos ofrece la ocasión de revivir los momentos fundamentales de nuestra Redención. Pero no olvidemos que —, «para acompañar a Cristo en su gloria, al final de la Semana Santa, es necesario que penetremos antes en su holocausto, y que nos sintamos una sola cosa con Él, muerto sobre el Calvario». Para eso, nada mejor que caminar de la mano de María. Que Ella nos obtenga la gracia de que estos días dejen una huella profunda en nuestras almas. Que sean, para cada una y cada uno, ocasión de profundizar en el Amor de Dios, para poder así mostrarlo a los demás.


