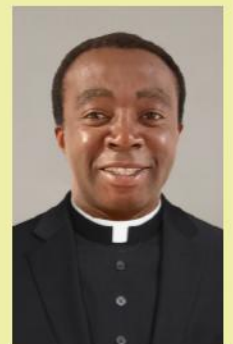

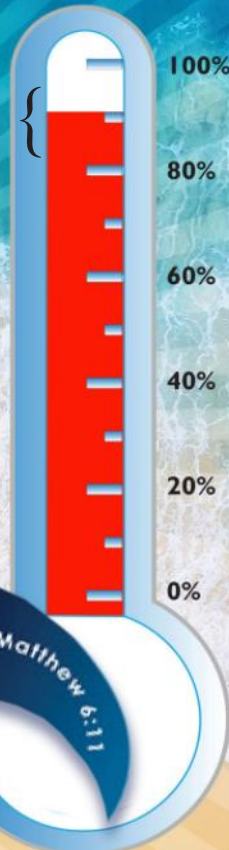

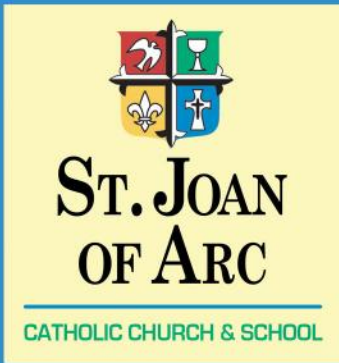

CHURCH ETIQUETTE AT ST. JOAN OF ARC CATHOLIC CHURCH

Mass attendance (required for Sundays and All “Holy Days of Obligation”) and praying to God for ourselves, our parish family, and others is an ideal way of living the Great Commandment: *“You shall love the Lord, your God, with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind ... [and] You shall love your neighbor as yourself.”* (Mt. 22:37, 39). We hope this helps all maximize the richness of each Mass:

- Before Mass, please
- Avail yourself of Sacramental Reconciliation, especially if you are aware of serious sin.
- Abstain from food and drink (except water, medicine, etc.) for 1 hour before Communion.
- Dress in your “Sunday Best” to reflect the reality that we are directly encountering God.
- Arrive at least several minutes early to spend some time in quiet prayer and reflection.
- Insure your devices are at least on silent (or powered off)
- Bless yourself with holy water and (if possible) genuflect before taking your seat.
- Keep any speaking to a low-volume minimum or step outside for conversation.
- During Mass, please
- Verbally respond to all the prayers and Mass parts throughout the liturgy
- Sing along to all the hymns and responsorial psalms.
- (If possible) kneel & stand during the appropriate times
- – Remember all Catholics who have received their 1st Communion, properly prepared, and have fasted for one hour are welcome to receive Holy Communion.
- – Bow when approaching minister of communion, and say “Amen,” to “Body of Christ” (or Blood of Christ) before receiving.
- – Receive the Body of Christ on your hand (left hand flat on top of right) — Please consume the Body of Christ immediately.
- – (If possible) kneel in silent prayer and reflection until the tabernacle is closed and priest is seated.
- After Mass, please
- Remain in your seat at least until the priest and assistants have processed completely down the center aisle (ideally wait until the final hymn concludes).
- Exit reverently (also as a courtesy for those who wish to remain for some extra prayer-time)

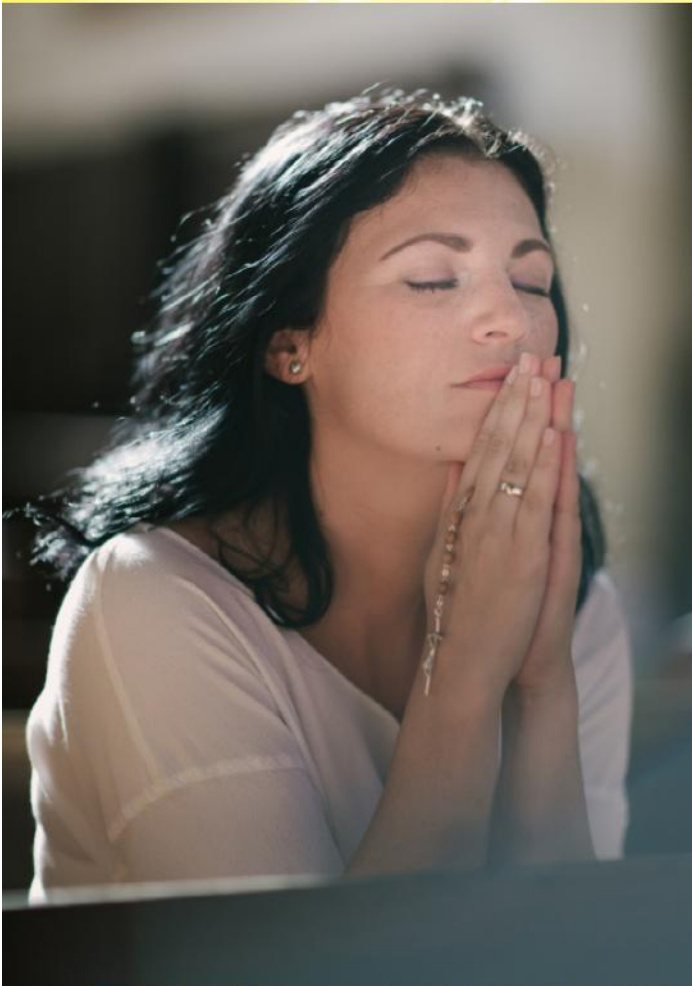

¡Queridos hermanos y hermanas!

“Los próximos meses nos conducirán a la apertura de la Puerta Santa, con la que comenzaremos el Jubileo. Les pido que intensifiquen la oración para prepararnos a vivir bien este acontecimiento de gracia y experimentar la fuerza de la esperanza de Dios. Por eso comenzamos hoy el Año de la oración, un año dedicado a redescubrir el gran valor y la absoluta necesidad de la oración en la vida personal, en la vida de la Iglesia y en el mundo. Nos ayudarán también los subsidios que el Dicasterio para la Evangelización pondrá a nuestra disposición.

En estos días recemos especialmente por la unidad de los cristianos, y no nos cansemos de invocar al Señor por la paz en Ucrania, en Israel y en Palestina, y en tantas otras partes del mundo: son siempre los más débiles los que sufren la falta de ella. Pienso en los pequeños, en tantísimos niños heridos y asesinados, en los privados de afecto, privados de sueños y de futuro. ¡Sintamos la responsabilidad de rezar y construir la paz para ellos!”

Como va nuestra oracion? Rezamos siempre con la confianza de sabernos hijos de Dios? Con aquellas oraciones vocales que aprendimos en nuestra infancia y que nos llevan a tener una constante actitud de adoración y de petición.?

Como nos dice el Santo Padre, hay muchas cosas por las que rezar: la paz en el mundo, en la Iglesia, en las familias, en nuestros corazones.
