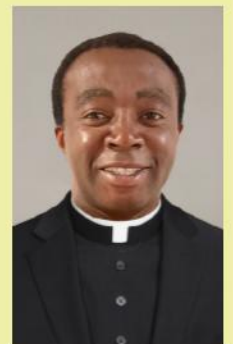

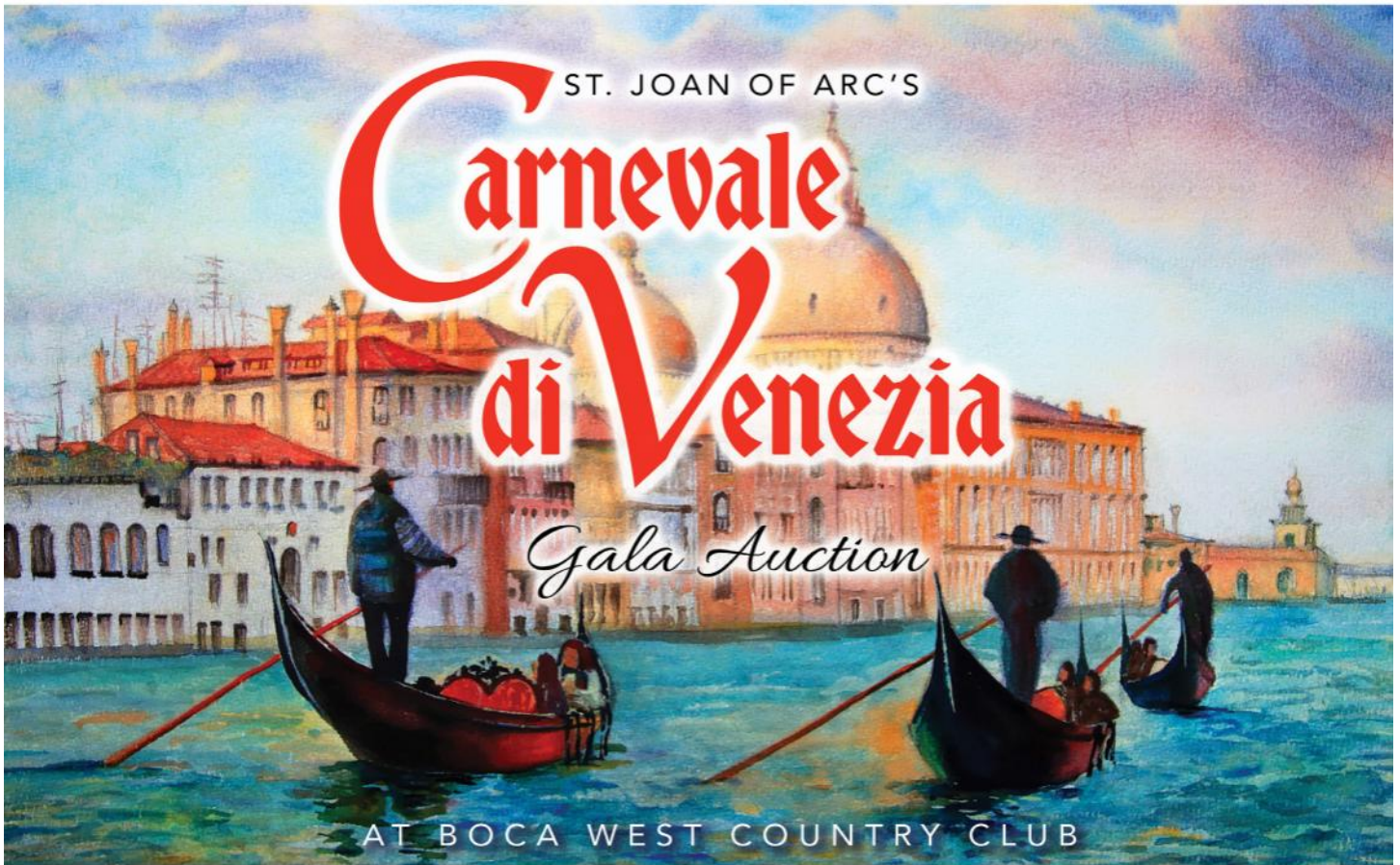

## Procesión del Señor de los Milagros

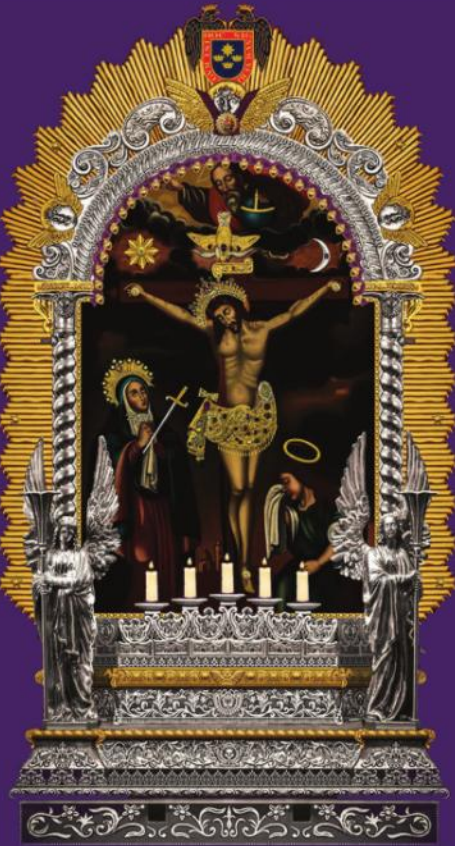
La procesión del Señor de los Milagros de Nazarenas, se realiza tradicionalmente en el mes de octubre en Lima, Perú. Es una de las procesiones más grandes del mundo. La veneración al Señor de los Milagros se originó después que terremotos en los siglos 17 y 18 causaron derrumbes en la ciudad, sin embargo, la pared simple de adobe donde se encontró la imagen de Cristo permaneció intacta. El color predominante para la procesión y para los hábitos que usan los feligreses es el morado.

## The Lord of Miracles Procession

Every year in October, hundreds of thousands of pilgrims from all walks of life participate in a procession honoring the image of The Lord of Miracles in Lima, Peru. It is one of the largest religious processions in the world. Its name originated in the 17 and 18th centuries, after many earthquakes destroyed most of the city, leaving only the adobe mural with the image of Christ standing. The predominant color for the procession and the habits is purple.

# SJA's Knights of Columbus Sponsors The Silver Rose



Join us, pray and reflect as  
The Silver Rose visits  
St. Joan of Arc Church  
on **Thursday, August 15th**  
at **6:00pm**, honoring Our  
Lady of Guadalupe and our  
unity and dedication to the  
sanctity of human life.



The next Pilgrimage visiting St. Joan of Arc is the Silver Rose. Traveling through the Diocese of Palm Beach from August 9 thru August 15, 2024. Transported by the Knights of Columbus, **Knights on Bikes**, these are Knights of Columbus mostly fourth degree members, who ride motorcycles.

The Silver Rose began in 1960 with the Squires Council 2312, running a rose to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Monterrey Mexico, to commemorate Juan Diego and the miracle of the roses. The first rose was a natural rose and was blessed by Bishop John C. Cody in London. It was flown to New York, received by Grand Knight Joseph Thomasen, who took it to Supreme Knight Luke E. Hart. Who shepherded it to the Dallas, Texas State Deputy Jack Collerin, who took it to Laredo, Texas. It was given to Squires on the International Bridge in Laredo. They ran the rose from the International Bridge thru Sabinas Hidalgo NI, Mexico, to Clenega de Flores and on to the Bailica in Monerrey Mexico, on December 12, 1960.

After 1961, the program expanded, a perfect program for the Knights of Columbus, through it we honor not only Our Lady of Guadalupe and express the unity of the Order, but we also reaffirm the Order's dedication to the sanctity of human life. It is the Blessed Mother that we turn-to in prayer, as we work to end the culture of death, that grips our society. As we think in terms of "*One Life, One Rose*". Under Supreme Knight Carl Anderson, the program expanded to eight silver roses, traveling North American routes including: Canada, every US State, Puerto Rico and District of Columbia, and Mexico. The tradition spreads to Our Lady of Guadalupe and embodies International Brotherhood as jointly nurtured across the continent.

This year the Silver Rose will be brought to St Joan of Arc Church, by the Diocese of Palm Beach Knights on Bikes on Thursday, August 15th at 6:00pm, honoring the Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

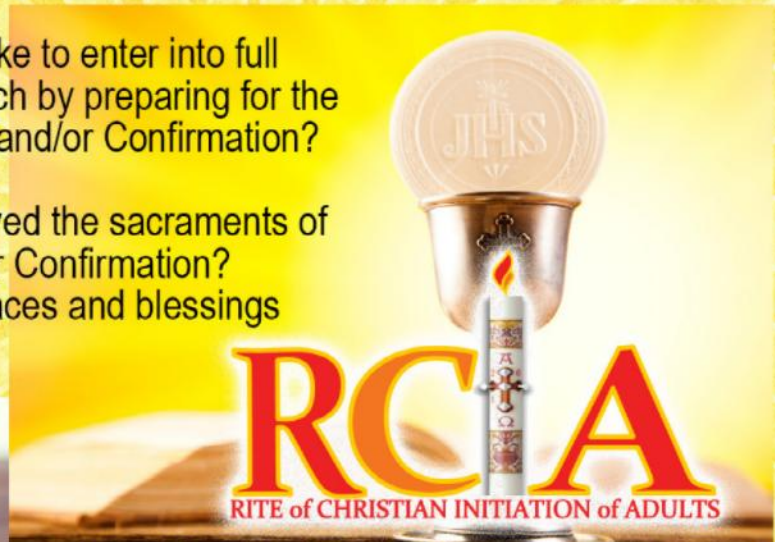
