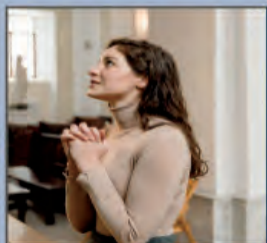

Trigésimo Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario
Primera Lectura: Eclesiástico 35: 12-14, 16-18
Segunda Lectura: 2 Timoteo 4: 6-8, 16-18
Evangelio: Lucas 18: 9-14

La semana pasada comenzó en Santa Juana de Arco el programa de catequesis para niños pequeños a partir de los tres años: la "Catequesis del Buen Pastor", basada en el descubrimiento de la doctora María Montessori sobre cómo aprenden los niños. La doctora Montessori era una médica italiana nacida en 1870 que murió en 1952; al iniciar su trabajo descubrió cualidades de los niños pequeños desconocidas e impensadas en su época:

- La capacidad espiritual del niño y
- El anhelo del niño por el Misterio de Dios.

La Catequesis del Buen Pastor es una forma de formación religiosa fundada en este conocimiento. No utiliza series de libros catequéticos, no tiene lugar en un aula tradicional; en su lugar, se realiza en un espacio preparado para niños en el cual cada objeto ayuda a conocer a Dios.

La simplicidad y el orden reinan allí. La oración y el trabajo son todos apropiados para la edad de los niños; en este lugar el niño entra en contacto con la Escritura y la liturgia.

La Catequesis del Buen Pastor nutre el desarrollo espiritual de los niños de 3 a 12 años de edad.

Sofía Cavalletti (la pionera de la Catequesis del Buen Pastor en los Estados Unidos y otros lugares) dijo:

"Si retrasamos la catequesis hasta la edad habitual de 6 años, el niño ha entrado en una nueva etapa ética de la vida cuando Dios es más probable que sea percibido como juez, mientras que el niño más joven es especialmente receptivo a la iniciativa amorosa de Dios. A esta edad y con el enfoque Montessori, los niños aprenden no de manera académica sino como si la Biblia y la Liturgia formarían parte de su persona."

Cuando María Montessori comenzó su trabajo con niños pequeños en Barcelona en 1922, ella eligió la palabra "Atrio" para identificar su modo de catequesis. Esto es lo que dijo:

"En la iglesia primitiva había un local especial, llamado el atrio, generalmente contiguo a la iglesia, que se usaba para la instrucción de los catecúmenos. Era, por así decirlo, una especie de antesala de la iglesia, tanto en un sentido literal como metafórico.

Este cuarto, uno podría llamarlo el Atrio, estará reservado para la preparación de los niños pequeños para su plena participación en la vida de la iglesia.

No se trataría simplemente de enseñarles su catecismo sino algo mucho más amplio y profundo.

Este cuarto será un lugar donde nacería y se nutriría el sentimiento religioso, donde los niños estarían libres para la expresión de sus instintos religiosos."

María Montessori, a inicios de 1900, escribió consistentemente sobre el amor del niño pequeño al orden, la capacidad de concentración, el deseo de trabajo y el amor por el silencio; estas características inspiran el Atrio.

Muebles de tamaño infantil, objetos móviles, y cada material tiene su propio lugar en la estantería de la Escritura o en la estantería de la Litúrgica. Luego hay "centros" en la sala: el área del Bautismo, la mesa del Altar, un área geográfica, un rincón de oración.

La sala tiene cierta solemnidad; se le muestra al niño cómo caminar despacio y hablar suavemente, un ambiente de silencio permea el Atrio.

La sesión de 2 horas ofrece al niño tiempo para escuchar, trabajar, orar, cantar, maravillarse, descansar y discutir cosas importantes.

En el silencio del Atrio, los niños descubren que tienen una vida interior.

Es un ambiente que motivó a un niño a exclamar:
"¿Podría vivir aquí!"
