## DAY 7: SAN GIOVANNI ROTONDO/ MONTE SANT' ANGELO



# Sta. Juana DE Arco



La tradición occidental habla de tres personajes: Melchor, Gaspar y Baltasar. Los Reyes Magos que se dirigieron con prisa a Belén, llenos de alegría al ver reaparecer la estrella, un signo sobrenatural dado por Dios a esos hombres elegidos. Nada más salir de Jerusalén —prosigue San Mateo—, la estrella que habían visto en Oriente se colocó delante de ellos, hasta pararse sobre el sitio donde estaba el Niño. Y, entrando en la casa, vieron al Niño con María, su Madre; y postrándose le adoraron. Luego abrieron sus cofres y le ofrecieron presentes: oro, incienso y mirra ( Mt 2, 9-11).

«La llegada de los Magos de Oriente a Belén, para adorar al Mesías recién nacido, es la señal de la manifestación del Rey universal a los pueblos y a todos los hombres que buscan la verdad. Es el inicio de un movimiento opuesto al de Babel: de la confusión a la comprensión, de la dispersión a la reconciliación. Por consiguiente, descubrimos un vínculo entre la Epifanía y Pentecostés: si el nacimiento de Cristo, la Cabeza, es también el nacimiento de la Iglesia, su cuerpo, en los Magos vemos a los pueblos que se agregan al resto de Israel, anunciando la gran señal de la "Iglesia políglota" realizada por el Espíritu Santo cincuenta días después de la Pascua.

Sagrada familia de Jesus, Maria y José Primera Lectura: Sirácides 3:2-6, 12-14 Segunda Lectura: Colosenses 3:12-21 Evangelio: Mateo 2:13-15, 19-23 La Epifania del Señor Primera Lectura: Isaias 60:1-6 Segunda Lectura: Efesios 3:2-3.5-6 Evangelio: Mateo 2:1-2 Cuando, en las primeras páginas de la Biblia, encontramos el momento de la creación del hombre, leemos que fue formado a «imagen» de Dios, hecho a su «semejanza». Este modelo divino está siempre presente en lo más íntimo del alma y, si entrenamos nuestra mirada, podremos entrever a Dios en cada hombre y en cada mujer.

Los apóstoles de Jesús vivieron durante tres años, con quien era su mejor amigo, sin separarse de su lado. Le llamaban Rabbi –que quiere decir «maestro» – porque, además de amigos, eran y se sentían sus discípulos. «Como yo os he amado, amaos también unos a otros» . Y añadió: «En esto conocerán que sois mis discípulos» es decir: mis amigos serán reconocidos por su modo de guerer a los demás. Pero, ¿cómo es este amor?, ¿cuáles son sus características? El amor de Cristo por sus apóstoles es precisamente un amor como el que se tienen los amigos. Jesús cuidaba a las personas con las que convivía. Se alegraba con sus alegrías y sufría con su dolor . Siempre encontró tiempo para detenerse con los demás: con la samaritana, con la hemorroísa, e incluso con el buen ladrón, cuando estaba ya colgado de la cruz. El de Jesús era un cariño que se manifestaba en lo concreto: se preocupaba por el alimento de guienes le seguían, y también por su descanso. Como nos recuerda el papa Francisco, Jesús «cuidó la amistad con sus discípulos, e incluso en los momentos críticos permaneció fiel a ellos» La amistad «es mirar al otro no para servirse de él, sino para servirlo». Se entiende, entonces, que sea inherente a la amistad el «desinterés», porque la intención del que ama no persigue ningún beneficio ni un posible efecto boomerang. Descubrir esto en su auténtica profundidad siempre sorprende, pues parece chocar con una idea de la vida como competición, que puede ser común en algunos ambientes. Por eso, quien experimenta la amistad lo hace habitualmente como un regalo inmerecido; con amigos los problemas de la vida parecen más ligeros. Como dice un proverbio kikuyu ( Kenia): «Cuando en lo alto de la montaña hay un amigo, resulta más fácil subir». Los amigos son absolutamente necesarios para alcanzar una vida feliz.

Conociendo la vida de Jesús y creciendo en intimidad con él podemos aprender los rasgos de una amistad perfecta. El cristiano tiene un gran amor –un don– que compartir. Nuestras relaciones con los demás le dan a Cristo la posibilidad de ofrecer su amistad a nuevos amigos.




