
**Bishop David J. Bonnar**

The Most Reverend David J. Bonnar is the sixth Bishop of the Diocese of Youngstown, appointed by Pope Francis in November 2020 and installed in January 2021. A native of Pittsburgh, Bishop Bonnar was ordained a priest in 1988 after seminary studies in Rome, where he earned a degree in Sacred Theology from the Pontifical Gregorian University.

Throughout nearly four decades of priestly ministry, Bishop Bonnar has served the Church with great dedication as a parish priest, seminary rector, Director of Vocations, and Episcopal Vicar for Clergy. He has also been deeply involved in the formation and support of priests and deacons and is well known for his pastoral leadership and love for parish life. In addition, he has served the wider Church as editor of *The Priest* magazine and as a member of the USCCB National Advisory Board. For twelve years he was also chaplain to the Pittsburgh Steelers.

We are blessed to welcome Bishop David J. Bonnar as the preacher for our Lenten Mission, and we look forward to the wisdom, faith, and pastoral heart he will share with us during these grace-filled days.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

Next weekend, March 7/8, parishes in the Diocese of Palm Beach will take up the annual second collection for education of seminarians and formation of priests. The funds raised in this collection are used to cover the cost of tuition, housing, education and pastoral training of our eight seminarians. Those expenses are significant and rising all the time.

The yearly cost of tuition for one seminarian is now about \$25,000, and the yearly room and board for one seminarian is \$15,000. Thanks to your assistance, our seminarians are able to journey in faith without being financially burdened and can devote themselves fully to priestly formation. Since the last collection, we celebrated the ordinations of Father Jude Okeke in May 2025 and Father Jedidiah Preble in January 2026.

St. Paul said, "I am confident of this, that the one who began a good work in you will continue to complete it until the day of Christ Jesus" (Phil 1:6). May the excellent work of forming our seminarians, along with your fervent prayers, pay abundant dividends with an increase in vocations for many years to come.

En este segundo domingo de Cuaresma, por otra parte, nos trasladamos al monte Tabor para asistir al acontecimiento glorioso de la Transfiguración del Señor. Si en el desierto «vemos a Jesús plenamente hombre, que comparte con nosotros incluso la tentación», en el Tabor «lo contemplamos como Hijo de Dios, que diviniza nuestra humanidad»[1]. Sin embargo, a pesar del contraste, ambos sucesos anticipan el misterio pascual: «La lucha de Jesús con el tentador prelude el gran duelo final de la Pasión, mientras la luz de su cuerpo transfigurado anticipa la gloria de la Resurrección»

Pedro, Santiago y Juan, al subir al Tabor, se ven inmersos inesperadamente en la oración de Jesús. Ellos habían contemplado muchas veces en el pasado el rostro del Maestro; le habían mirado mientras oraba, cuando predicaba la llegada del Reino o curaba muchos enfermos. Quizás habían visto reflejados en el rostro de Cristo los sentimientos que llenaban su corazón. Sin embargo, en la cima del Tabor ven de una manera nueva ese rostro tan amado. Jesús revela su gloria a los tres amigos: «Se transfiguró ante ellos, de modo que su rostro se puso resplandeciente como el sol, y sus vestidos blancos como la luz» (Mt 17,2). Es tal la impresión que les produjo la contemplación del cuerpo glorioso del Señor, que Pedro, entusiasmado, exclamó sin saber lo que decía: «Qué bien estamos aquí; si quieres haré aquí tres tiendas: una para ti, otra para Moisés y otra para Elías» (Mt 17,4) «La oración es la elevación del alma a Dios»[4]; es un espacio de silencio ante Dios, a donde acudimos para llenarnos de él, para saciar nuestra sed. Los discípulos fueron arrebatados por lo que veían en el Tabor. Porque esa experiencia tenía que permanecer en los corazones como luz y fuerza de su fe; también una luz y fuerza para los días venideros: los de la Pasión”.
