





Parish welcomes home newly ordained priest

BOCA RATON | Newly ordained Father Jedidiah Preble expressed his appreciation for those at St. Joan of Arc in Boca Raton who had prayed for him during his priestly formation. He celebrated a Mass of thanksgiving Feb. 22, 2026, with Father Nestor Rodriguez, pastor, and Father Peter Wojuaye.

The St. Joan of Arc community had been asked by Father Preble's mother, Constanza Preble, who works at the parish and school, to pray for her son as he transitioned from ordination as a deacon to the priesthood. On Jan. 31, Father Preble was ordained a priest by Bishop Gerald M. Barbarito at the Cathedral of St. Ignatius Loyola and assigned to serve as parochial vicar at St. Juliana in West Palm Beach. "I want to thank everyone who prayed for my son," she said.

"It's not every day that we have a young man who has just been ordained a priest come to celebrate one of his first Masses at our parish," Father Rodriguez said as he welcomed the faithful. "We are so grateful to God, and we welcome Father Jedidiah Preble. It's wonderful to have you here."

A jubilant Father Preble thanked Father Rodriguez, adding the Mass was a special event for him.

"My family has been involved as part of this parish in some way or another for over 20 years," he said. "This is my parish where I got ordained (as a transitional deacon) right here," and after becoming a deacon, "I have been involved in little ways here with the religious education, especially the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd."

Father Preble's homily focused on making a good confession with a thorough examination of conscience. Explaining how to make a good examination of conscience, he advised, "At night, ask yourself three questions: What have I done poorly today? What have I done well? And what can I do better tomorrow?"

Catechesis of the Good Shep-

herd, a hands-on learning program for young children, was recently instituted at the parish by religious education director Andrea Lewin, who said, "I thought it was a good idea to get certified, and very few diocesan churches have this program established."

Patty Delaney, director of parish administration and communications, said in an email to the Florida Catholic that "Father Jedidiah is the only priest in the diocese who has completed the training as a catechist for the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, Catholic-based Montessori classes that have launched in our parish, thanks to the efforts of our religious education program, led by Andrea Lewin and Constanza Preble."

Lewin explained how the program started at St. Joan. "I began exploring the idea of bringing the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd to our parish after Lilliana Soto-Cabrera from the Office of Marriage, Family Life, Faith Formation and Youth Ministry mentioned to me that the Diocese of Palm Beach offered the program.

"With the approval of Father Nestor Rodriguez, I took the initiative to begin the certification process and invited three people

to join me — then-Deacon Jedidiah, along with Constanza Preble and Ines Amengual," she said. "We began our training in July 2025 and officially received our certification in January 2026."

On the second floor of St. Joan of Arc's Mercy Center there is a learning environment called an atrium that contains child-size educational tools. "With God's grace, we were able to complete the Level I atrium for children ages 3 to 6 in record time, and we began classes in October," Lewin said. "The school currently has 13 students," with the hope of opening "Level II as soon as possible."

Father Preble said, "Catechesis of the Good Shepherd is obviously good for little children because it introduces them to a life of faith in a very practical way, and children learn in that way (hands-on). Most of us don't learn in a classroom; we learn by living. But I also think it is important for adults."

Asked if CGS makes the liturgy come alive for children, Father Preble answered, "Yes, that's right, and I think that every sacrifice and anybody who works in the church, anybody who works in liturgy, should go to the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and should do at least the Grace and Manners



part because it teaches you how to walk around the sanctuary," and it teaches the difference between "sacred space and sacred time and your regular time."

There was a reception in the Mercy Center following the Mass. Laurie Colbert, sitting at the check-in table, said, "I am so thankful to the Holy Spirit for gracing us with another priest, and Father Jedidiah is going to be

a blessed addition." ■

2025-2026 ISSUE CAMPAIGNS

Mental Health

Florida ranks 40th in mental health service availability. Because of this, many individuals receive emergency care, but are discharged without follow-up. This leaves individuals and families confused, scared, and in crisis.

That's why PEACE is advocating for Florida Assertive Community Treatment Teams (FACT Teams). FACT Teams provide wrap-around services, striving to keep individuals in community. **Palm Beach County has two FACT Teams – we need five by 2029.**

That's why PEACE is pushing our state senators and representatives to include funding for FACT Teams in the 2026-27 state budget. We are also working to get the Health Care District of Palm Beach County to run these teams.

Police-Community Relations

Each year, thousands of African American and Hispanic residents of Palm Beach County experience “investigatory stops”. When stopped, these individuals are asked things like “who’s car is this” or “why are you in this neighborhood”. People of color feel targeted, leading to growing mistrust of the police.

In 2024, Sheriff Ric Bradshaw began tracking data on all traffic stops, including those that result in a verbal warning only. He also committed to contract with an outside agency to analyze this data and to meet with PEACE to review the data. We will be hearing the outcome of this analysis at the Action.

Affordable Housing

There’s an affordable housing crisis, especially for those making below 60% of the area median income (\$62,400 for a family of four). **It is these families that are one paycheck away from homelessness.**

That’s why PEACE is focused on increasing the number of affordable apartments in our community. We are asking our County Commissioners to create an Affordable Rental Housing Program that requires developers to set aside a certain number of apartments for this population.

Quinto domingo de Cuaresma
Primera Lectura: Ezequiel 37:12-14
Segunda Lectura: Romanos 8:8-11
Evangelio: Juan 11:1-45

Después de los pasajes de los domingos pasados sobre la samaritana y el ciego de nacimiento, que nos revelaban a Jesús como agua viva y luz del mundo, este quinto domingo de Cuaresma nos presenta el relato de la resurrección de Lázaro, el séptimo signo o milagro narrado por san Juan, el último y más portentoso, y que revela a Jesús como señor de la vida y de la muerte. San Juan señala que Marta, María y Lázaro eran amigos de Jesús. Fruto de esta confianza mutua, las hermanas hacen llegar al Maestro la noticia de que su hermano está enfermo. El evangelista añade que “Jesús amaba a Marta, a su hermana y a Lázaro”, Jesús se conmovió y “rompió a llorar” (v. 35). Este cariño del Señor siempre ha despertado el asombro de los santos y su afán de correspondencia.”

Dice el relato que “todavía no había llegado Jesús a la aldea” (v. 30) cuando llamó en secreto a Marta para que acudiera hasta Él. Quizá Jesús hizo esto para no incomodar a las hermanas, de luto, con el alojamiento del Maestro y sus discípulos, o para no comprometer a sus amigos, ya que los judíos lo buscaban para matarlo (cfr. v. 8). En cualquier caso, Marta llega y demuestra su gran fe en Jesús. Luego avisa a María, que se prostra ante el Maestro delante de todos, sin respetos humanos, y conmueve al Señor.

“En el Evangelio de hoy —comentaba Benedicto XVI—, escuchamos la voz de la fe de labios de Marta, la hermana de Lázaro. A Jesús, que le dice: ‘Tu hermano resucitará’, ella responde: ‘Sé que resucitará en la resurrección en el último día’ (Jn 11, 23-24). Y Jesús replica: ‘Yo soy la resurrección y la vida: el que cree en mí, aunque haya muerto, vivirá’ (Jn 11, 25). Esta es la verdadera novedad, que irrumpe y supera toda barrera. Cristo derrumba el muro de la muerte; en él habita toda la plenitud de Dios, que es vida, vida eterna. Por esto la muerte no tuvo poder sobre él; y la resurrección de Lázaro es signo de su dominio total sobre la muerte física, que ante Dios es como un sueño (cf. Jn 11, 11)”[1]. Una vez abierto el sepulcro, Jesús grita: “¡Lázaro, sal fuera!” (v. 43). Lázaro era la forma griega del nombre hebreo Eleazar, que significa ayuda de Dios. Lázaro se convierte en el preludio de lo anunciado por Jesús: “Viene la hora, cuando los muertos oirán la voz del Hijo de Dios, y los que la oyeren vivirán” (Jn 5,25). Jesús tiene poder sobre la muerte porque también lo tiene sobre el pecado, que es su causa. Por eso de algún modo, los lienzos que atan y envuelven a Lázaro representan no solo las ligaduras del sheol sino también las del pecado.

El Papa Francisco lo explicaba así: “el gesto de Jesús que resucita a Lázaro muestra hasta dónde puede llegar la fuerza de la Gracia de Dios, y por lo tanto, donde puede llegar nuestra conversión, nuestro cambio... ¡No hay ningún límite a la misericordia divina ofrecida a todos! El Señor está siempre listo para levantar la piedra tumbar de nuestros pecados, que nos separa de Él, luz de los vivientes”[4]. Si nos fijamos en un detalle, Jesús no actúa directamente sobre Lázaro, sino que cuenta con la mediación de otros para que lo desaten. En estos colaboradores pueden verse simbolizados también los ministros en la Iglesia que absuelven los pecados.
