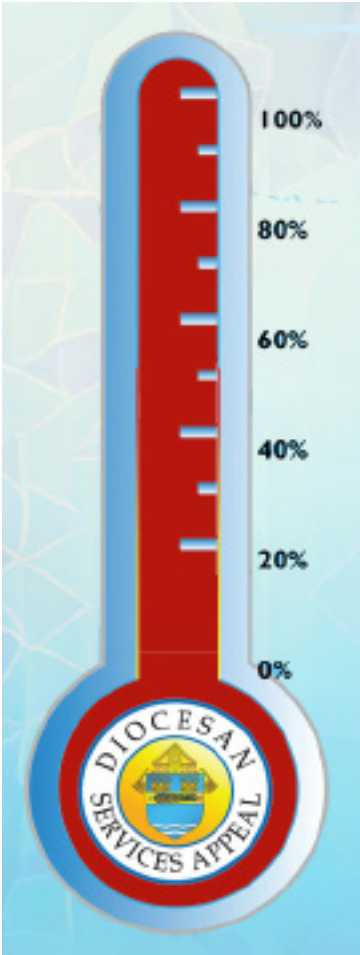

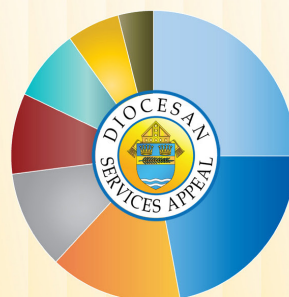

The graph below shows our **annual offertory and expenses from 2007 through 2025**.

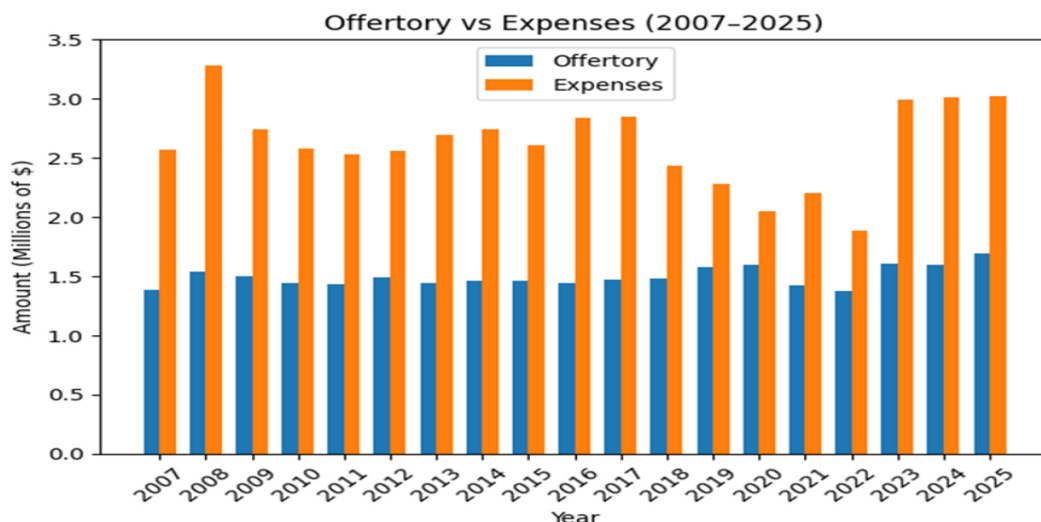
