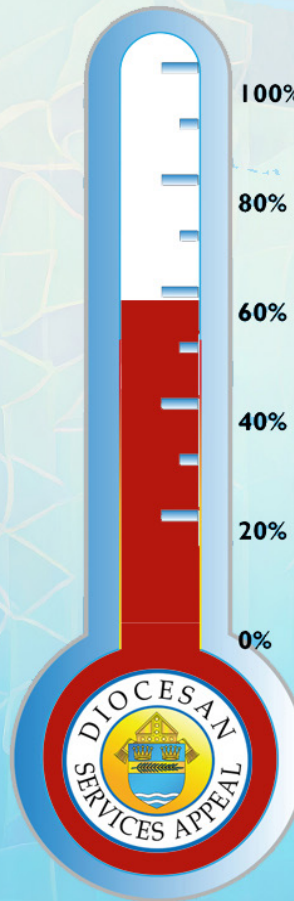
Did you know?

Safe Environment training is taking place in all dioceses in the United States. In 2023-2024, 2,256,796 adults were trained to prevent and report abuse and 2,237,906 underwent background checks in US dioceses or eparchies. In addition, 2,851,850 children were also given tools to protect themselves from those who might harm them.

Working alongside the Bishop, the Office of Safe Environments reinforces the ongoing implementation of policies and procedures that protect children and the vulnerable.

During the most recent year 2023-2024, the Diocese of Palm Beach reported 19,842 active Safe Environment participants including all clergy, parish and school employees, volunteers and minors who received safe environment training.
