PEACE is an inter-religious coalition organizing across more than 20 congregations across Palm Beach County to solve systemic community problems.

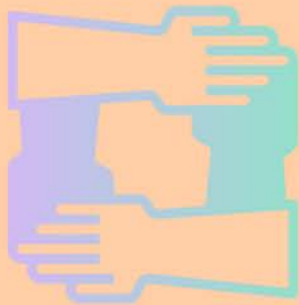
St. Joan is embarking on a series of meetings and planning sessions with the goal of understanding how the seven principles of Catholic social teaching guide us to live out "thy Kingdom come on earth" in the here and now, and how this mission can be executed through PEACE at the parish. The response to our first reflection was incredibly lively—26 people gathered on Tuesday, July 14 in the Church Alcove! We listened, talked, prayed, and looked forward to taking our next steps together.

As a result of that initial meeting, St. Joan has decided to hold a series of listening sessions that we hope will both plant and nourish seeds for a targeted official joining during the **Spring 2027 Nehemiah Action Assembly**. Each session will include a discussion of one or more of the Catholic Social Doctrine teachings, listening sessions to get your thoughts on the key issues in our community and additional sharing on how the PEACE organization will be built out within our parish.

We absolutely desire this to be an all-parish mission—a way in which we can all rise together in service to our Lord—and we know that with each of you, together we will create a successful, lasting, and impactful ministry.

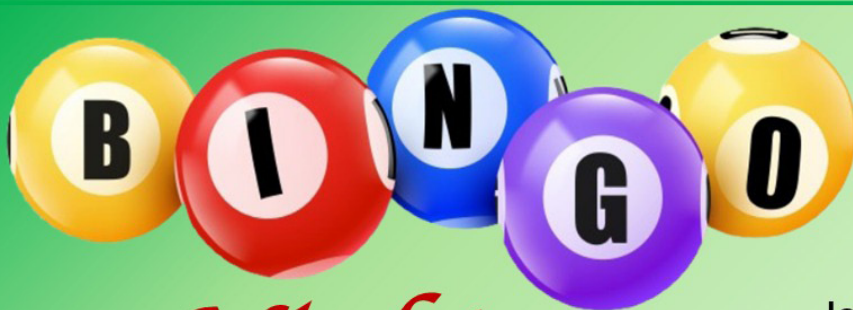
